Principles underlying the creation of Math for the Master (y):

- 1. **Simplicity** (large print, uncluttered pages, straightforward instruction)
- 2. **Ease of use** (no large amounts of prep time for Mom)
- 3. **Brevity** (allows a family to "redeem the time" and move on to other things)
- 4. **Flexibility** (parental direction in each child's individualized study)
- 5. **Strong mathematical foundations** ("line upon line, precept upon precept" one concept mastered before another is introduced.)
- 6. **Sensibility** ("Let all things be done decently and in order." Practice and success with the small things before moving on to larger things.)
- 7. **Excellence** (focus on mastery "Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might.")
- 8. **Usefulness** (plenty of practice with useable math, not a lot of theory)
- 9. **Practicality** (affordable, non-consumable)
- 10. **Importance of God and family** (word problems with Christian family as the central focus)
